SPAGHETTI DINNER 2010

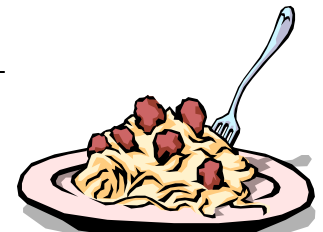
